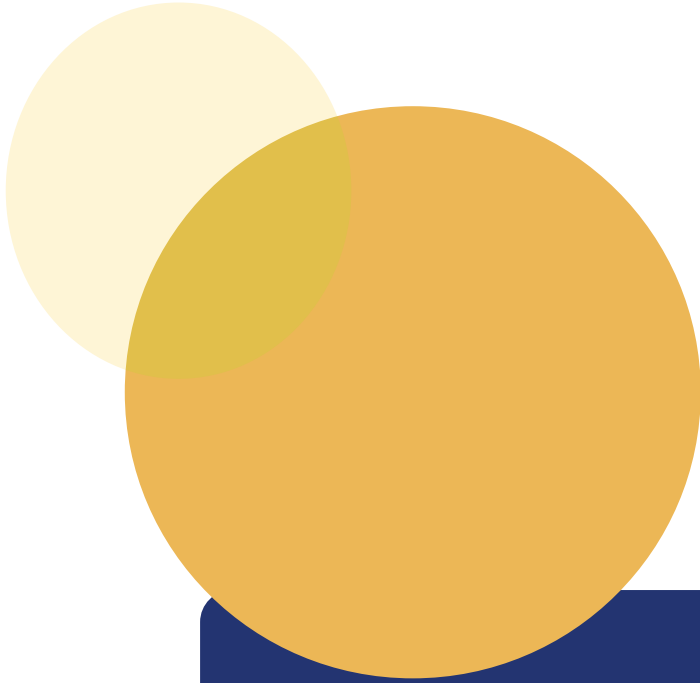

Abantu baffe mwenna mu bitundu eby'enjawulo yonna gyemuli ebweru wa Uganda, naddala mmwe abatuula mu mambuka g'Amerika tubeebaza nnyo olw'obujjumbize mu nteekateeka z'Obwakabaka era n'olw'okuteekateeka olukungaana luno.

Ekiseera kino, ne gye buvuddeko, kibadde kizibu nnyo olw'obulwadde bwa Ssenyiga omukambwe Kolona (COVID 19) era nsaasira bannaffe bonna abafiiriddwa ab'enganda zaabwe olw'obulwadde obwo; so wakyaliwo abakyalina okusoomoozebwa olw'obulwadde obwo. Tukimanyi waliwo abali mu malwaliro; waliwo abaafiirwa emirimu; n'abo abaafuna obukosefu obwakyusa embeera y'obulamu bwabwe. Tubasaasidde nnyo.

Twebaza Katonda olw'abo abassuuka era tumusaba atutaase obulwadde buno. Mbakubiriza okugoberera okulambika kw'abasawo n'abakulembeze okusobola okwewala n'okumalawo, obulwadde buno. Tubeebazza olw'okudduukirira abantu baffe mu kiseera ky'omuggalo ekyali ekizibu ennyo.

Mbeebaza okuwagira emirimu gya Katikkiro wamu ne Kabineeti ya Kabaka awamu n'okugoberera amawulire n'ennambika ze babawa. Ebbanga lyonna Katikkiro amawulire gano agatutuusaako era mugende mu maaso. Lino ly'ekkubo erinayamba Obwakabaka bwaffe okwongera okunywera.

Twebaza ab'ekibiina kya Ggwanga Mujje Mid-West America n'abateesiteesi bonna olw'enteekateeka ey'omulundi guno egenda okubeera ku mutimbagano ku mulamwa **“Okusoomozebwa mu nkozesa y'ebyuma bi Kalimagezi”**.


Omulamwa guno mukulu nnyo mu kiseera kino kubanga enkozesa y'emitimbagano eyimirizibwawo nnyo ebyuma bi kalimagezi, weewawo n'ebirala, ng'essimu.

Ebirungi bingi bifunibwa mu nkozesa z'ebyuma bi kalimagezi, n'amagezi agagenderako. Kyokka tubasaba mwewale okukozesa obubi omutimbagano n'ebyuma bikalimagezi okutyoboola ennono n'obuwangwa bwaffe era n'okukotoggera enkulaakulana.

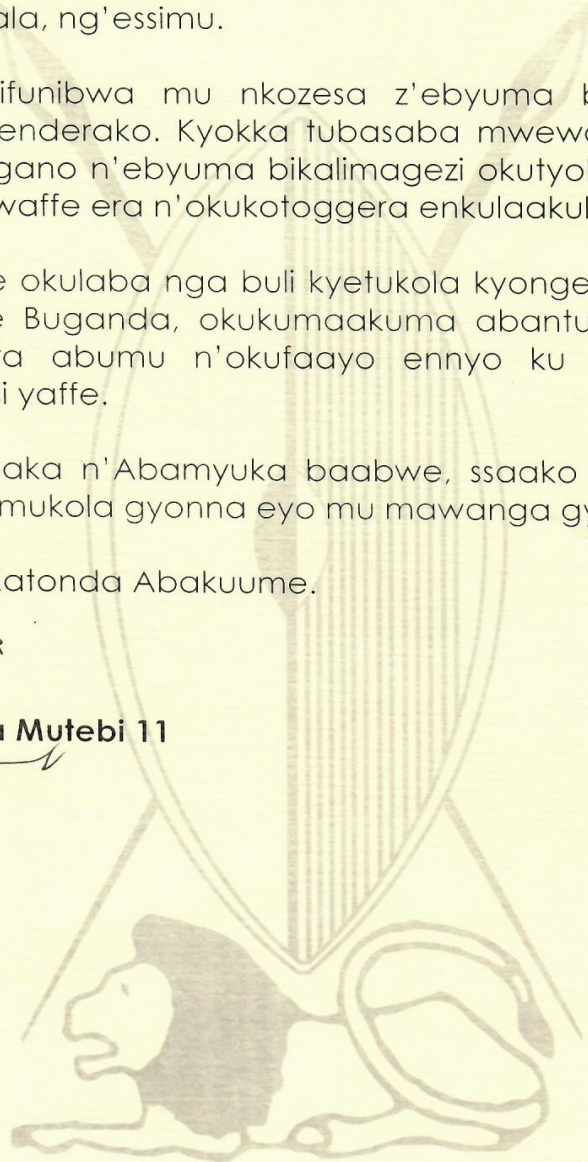

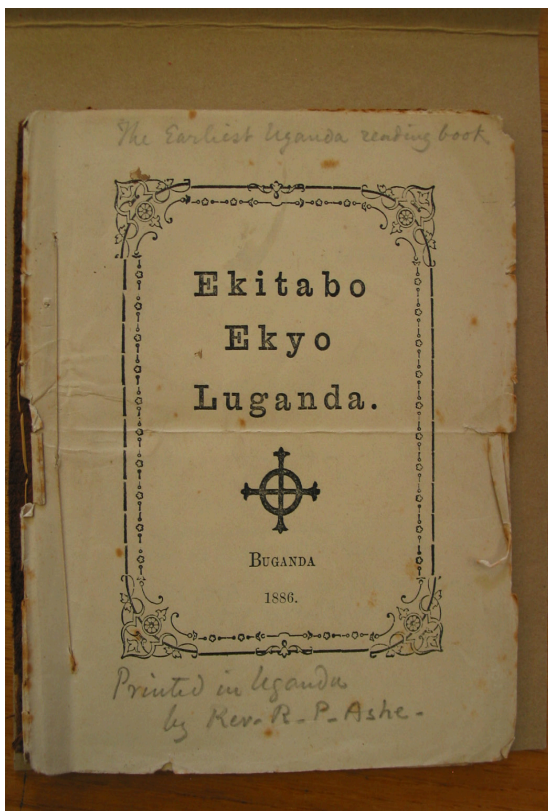

Mbalamusizza nnyo era mbeebaza emirimu gyonna gyemukola egyammwe n'egya nnyaffe Buganda. Nyongera okukubagiza abo bonna abafiiriddwa abantu baabwe wamu n'okusaasira abo bonna abasomoozeddwa olw'obulwadde bwa Lumiimamawuggwe (COVID 19), obutatde ensi yonna ku bunkenke.

Mbakulisa okubeera nga buli myaka ebiri muteekateeka olukungaana lwa Buganda Bumu North American Convention (BBNAC). Newankubadde nga ku mulundi guno gwandibadde muzibu olw'obulwadde bwa Lumiimamawuggwe, tekibalobedde kuteekateeka BBNAC 2021 ku mutimbagano.

Njozaayoza omubaka w'abantu ba Kabaka ow'e Chicago, Illinois ne banne olw' obutalemererwa. Kino kyolese obumalirivu n'obuyiia ng' emu ku nnyingo enkulu mu kaweeefube gwe tuliko ow'okuza Buganda ku Ntikko.

Waliwo ebibala ebirabwako ebivudde mu nkungaana zino, okugeza mwafunira Obwakabaka ambyulensi gye mwatona mu mwaka gwa 2015 n'eddwaliro eritambula (Mobile Clinic Bus) eryatongozebwa Ssaabasajja mu mwaka gwa 2018.

okwekkaanya engeri gyetugenda okweyambisa, oba okukozesa, tekinologiya okukulaakulanya Obwakabaka.

Ekiseera kye tulimu kya sayansi ne tekinologiya, era abo abanaalya ensi beebo abanassa omulaka ku by'enjigiriza. Awatali byanjigiriza tetusobola kufuna mu miganyulo gya sayansi ne tekinologiya.

Muli mu nsi erina obukugu obw'amaanyi ku ludda lwa sayansi ne tekinologiya. Kyandibadde kirungi ne mufuna emikago n'obusakirizi ku ludda olwo kubanga Obwakabaka bwasalawo okusoosowaza ensonga eno. Gye tunaakoma okwettanira sayansi ne tekinologiya gye tuggya okukomya okuleeta enkulaakulana mu Buganda ey'Omulembe Omutebi.

### OBUBAKA BWA MINISITA AVUNAANYIZIBWA KU NSONGA ZA BUGANDA EBWERU

Mbayozaayoza okutuuka ku buwanguzi ne muteekateeka olukunnaana lwa Buganda Bumumu America (BBNAC 2021) weewaawo nga ku mulundi guno lugenda kubeera ku Mutimbagano olw'obulwadde bwa Ssenyiga omukambwe Kolona (COVID-19).

Nkubagiza abo bonna abafiriddwa ab'ennaanda zaabwe olw'obulwadde buno obwajjira ensi yonna, era nsaasira nnyo bannaffe bonna abakoseddwa ssaako abasoomoozeddwa mu ngeri ez'enjawulo. Twebaza abaami ba Kabaka, abamyuka, n'enkiiko zonna, ssaako ebibiina ebigatta abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka olw'okufubanga okubeera nga bazze bakozesebwa mu ngeri ezitali zimu.

Bulijjo mu lukunnaana luno, tufuna omukisa okusisinkana n'okulabaganako wamu n'okuganyulwa mu miramwa egiteekebwatekebwa aten'ama bivuude mu bisaliddwawo era twenyumiriza nnyo mulukunnaana luno. Kyokka ne ku mulundi guno, weewaawo ensisi nkano tegenda kubeera ya maaso ku maaso, era tusuubira okubeerako byetutuukako okwongera amaanyi mu bumu mu bantu ba Ssaabasajja ababeera mu bitundu bya America y'omumambuka naddala ebiva mu mulamwa ogwategekebwa ogw'omulundi guno.

Ebirowoozo ebirungi ebisibuka mu lukangaana luno, tubyeyambisa okwongera okunyweza byetuluubirira okutuukako era omulamwa guno **“Okusoomoozebwa mu Nkozesa y'Ebyuma bi Kalimagezi – (Information Technology Challenges)”** tusuubira gugenda kutuyamba okutema empenda ezitwanguyiriza okuggusa ensonga Ssemasonga ettaano nga tweyambisa Tekinologiya. Ensonga ezo mwe muli;

- Okukuuma, okutaasa n'okunyweza Nnamulondo
- Okugabana obuyinza, emirimo n'obuvunaanyizibwa mu nfuga eya Federo
- Okukuuma ettaka n'ensalo za Buganda
- Okukola obutaweera okuddaabalula embeera z'abantu ba Kabaka mu by'enfuna, eby'obulamu n'ebyenjigiriza
- Okukuuma obumu bw'abantu ba Kabaka

Nga twefumiitiriza ku nkozesa ya Tekinologiya okusobola okuggusa ensonga ezo, bingi oba olyawo ebyanditutte ebbanga eddene, bisobola okutuukibwako mu bbanga ttono nnyo naddala nga tweyambisa omubala gw'olukunnaana luno ogugamba nti **“Buganda n'Omulembe gwa Tekinologiya”**.

Bwe twali mu lukiiko lwa BBNAC olwaggwa olwali mu Washington DC, waliwo ebiteeso bingi eby'amakulu ebyasalibwawo era nga bimaze n'okussibwa mu nkola, okugeza ababaka b'ebweru okwetaba mu Lukiiko lwa Buganda n'entuula z'obukiiko bw'olukiiko.

Okweyamba tekinologiya kwasobozesa ne Katikkiro okwogerako eri abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka abawangaalira mu nsi ez'enjawulo ebweru wa Uganda. Bingi abantu bye baayiga mu kwogera okwo, ebyabalambika ku bisaanye okukolebwa mu lugendo lw'okuzza Buganda ku Ntikko.

Nga Minisitule, bulijjo tugenda kweyambisanga tekinologiya okubamanyisa obuvunaanyizibwa bwa buli omu mu kuzimba nnyaffe Buganda. Twebaza nnyo abaami ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka e bunaayira, olw' okukola obutaweera, aba BBNAC abategesi b'olukunjaana lw' omwaka guno, n' abantu ba Ssaabasajja Kabaka mwenna olw' okulaga omwoyo gwa Buganda ogutafa.

Mu ngeri y'emu, nnyongera okubakubiriza okwongera okuwagira enteekateeka z'Obwakabaka zonna nga tweyambisa tekinologiya ate era tufube okwetangira ebyo oba abo abamukozesa okunafuya Obwakabaka.

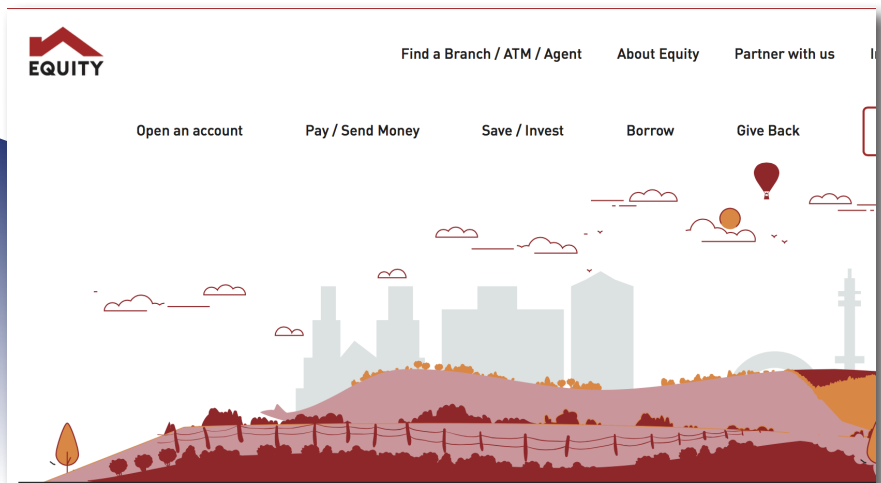

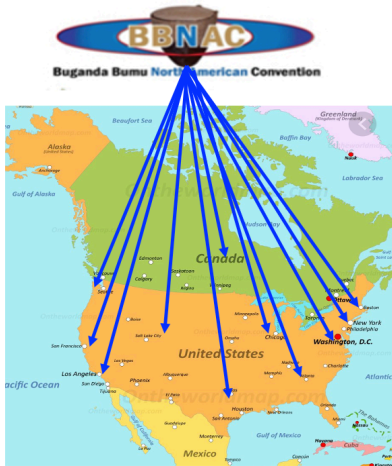

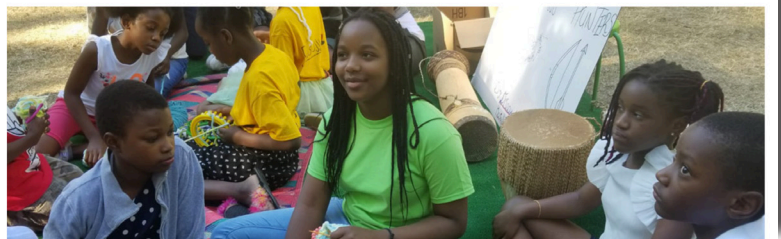

## Message from the BBNAC President



**K**u lw'akakiiko akafuzi aka Buganda Bumu North American Convention (BBNAC), Kntwala omukisa gun okwaniriza abagenyi baffe mwenna abetabye mu lukunjaana lwaffe luno olw'omulundi ogw'okuna.

Nneebaza nnyo aba Ggwanga Mujje Midwest (GMMW) n'abo bonna ababadde ku bukiiko obutegesi obw'enjawulo, abakoze omulimu omunene ennyo okutegeka olukiiko lwaffe luno olugatta abantu ba Ssaabasajja abawangaalira wano mu North America. Amaanyi, okwewaayo, n'obuvumu bwe mulazebituyambye okutuukiriza nokwongerera mu maaso obumu mu Baganda nemikwano gya Buganda abali wano.

Twaniriza n'essanyu ery'ensusso Maasomoogi Ssaabasajja Kabaka Ronald Muwenda Mutebi II okusiima okuggulawo olukunjaana lwaffe luno.

Twaniriza era Kamalabyonna wa Buganda, Charles Peter Mayiga, abalangira n'abambejja, abataka, abebitiibwa, ba minisita be Mengo, n'abakungu bonna abatwegasseeko olwaleero.

Ebibina by'Abaganda mu North American ekku-mi binnamukago, n'ababaka ba Ssaabasajja bakoze kinene nnyo okufuula BBNAC ekkunjaaniri ery'ensonga erireeta Abaganda okuteesa ku buwangwa n'ennono, enkulaakulana ne kw'ebyo byonna ebiba bitusoomooza. Nsaba munegatteko okwaniriza, era nokwebaza ebibiina byaffe bino: Ggwanga Mujje Midwest; Kamu Kamu Dallas; Agali Awamu Atlanta; Ggwanga Mujje DC; Ggwanga Mujje Boston; Bulungi Bwansi Buvanjuba; Colorado Buganda Heritage and Development Fund (BUDECA); Bulungi Bwansi Canada; Buganda Development Cultural Association; ne Buganda ey'Enkya California.

Twenyumiriza nnyo mu nteekateeka za BBNAC 2019, era ntuusa okwebaza eri abantu ba Ssaabasajja bonna okuva mu Gwanga Mujje DC abakola kyonna ekisoboka okutegeka omukolo ffenna ogwatuweesa ekitiibwa.

Twebaza Minisita Omubeezi wa Gavumenti ez'Ebitundu; Okulambula kwa Kabaka; era Avunaanyizibwa ku Nsonga z'Abaganda Ebweru, Oweekitiibwa Joseph Kawuki, olw'obuwabuzi, okututabaganya, era nokututuusiza ensonga zaffe embuga. Obuyambi bwe, bukoze kinene nnyo mu kaweeefube waffe ow'okuggumiza obumu n'enkolagana wakati w'abantu ba Ssaabasajja abali wano ne mu Buganda. Obuweereza bw'omulundi guno bubaddemu, era bukyalimu okusoomoozebwa kungi, era mu ngeri eno njagala okutuusa okusaasira kwaffe eri bannaffe bonna abanyigiriziddwa ki ssenyanga ekikambe, eby'obufuzi, ate nokusabira abo abaatuva ku maaso. Ki ssenyiga ekikambwe kireeseewo enkyukakyuka

nnyingi. Ffe aba BBNAC, kitulaze nti okunyweza obumu nga tulumirirwa nokufa ku banaffe, kintu kya bbeeyi ffenna kye twandisaanye okukuuma, okuddinjana, nokunyweza. Twalina okukyusa engeri gyetukolamu emirimu, era tekinologiya ye yafuuka obuddukiro okusobola okutambuza obuweereza nokusigala nga tuwuliziganya mu biseera eby'omug-galo.

Bwe twalaba emigaso egiri mu ku kozesa tekinologiya, twasalawo ekwenyigira mu kutuumbula omutindo, okumanyisa, okwagaza, nokuyamba abantu ba Ssaabasajja abali mu Buganda okukozesa tekinologiya, era kino kye kyatutuusa ku mulamwa gw'omwaka guno:

- 'Okusoomoozebwa mu Nkozesa y'Ebyuma bi Kalimagezi (IT Challenge).
- Omubala: 'Buganda n'Omulembe gwa Tekinologiya.' (Buganda and the Age of Technology)

Tusuubira okukwatira awamu n'ekitongole kya Ssaabasajja ekya tekinologiya okulaba nga twongera okwagazisa abavubuka tekinologiya, basobole okutumbula embeera zaabwe, nezabalala.

Bannange ab'akakiiko akafuzi, ssaako ne BBNAC Board of Directors, bakoze bwezizingirire okulaba nga BBNAC egenda mu maaso n'enteekateeka ez'enjawulo ezaasalibwawo mu nkiiko ezaggwa, ezigen-derera okutumbula embeera y'abantu ba Ssaabasajja wano ne mu Buganda, era nokuzza Buganda ku Ntikko.

Mu kkowe eryo, njagala okwebaza ennyo nnyini ddala abakulu bano wammanga, abakkiriza okwongezaayo ekisanja kyabwe eky'obukulembeze, okusobola okuteereza n'okukakasa nti BBNAC esigala ku musingi omulungi: Dr. Charles Muvawala Katende (BBNAC Vice President), Oweek. Dr. Abu Senkayi (Secretary), Oweek. Wycliffe Lule-Musoke (Publicity Secretary), Omumbejja Jackie Nakalema (Treasurer), Ssaalongo Francis Mubiru (Vice Treasurer). Abakulu bano bafu-bye nnyo okulaba ng'ebiteeso (Resolutions) ebiyisibwa mu nkiiko zaffe biggusibwa, era wammanga, z'entegeka zetwalina, nebyo ebikoleddwako:

- Enteekateeka ey'okwongera ekwenyigira mu kaweeefube ow'okuyamba abantu mu by'obulamu, era nga tutegeese olusiisira lw'ebyobulamu n'abasawo ebegattira mu kibiina kya **'Uganda North American Medical Association (UNAMS)'** okukikwasaganya ne Minisita w'Ebyobulamu, Oweek. Dr. Prosperous Nankindu. Olusiisira luno lwali lwakubeera Ggombe General Hospital mu Butambala, nga 06/20/20 – 06/27/20, naye olw'embeera ya kisenyigga ekyaali kyeriisa enkuli, twalina okulusazaamu. Njagala okwebaaza abakulu bano: Dr. Sarah Matovu, Dr. Frank Matovu, Dr. Joseph Buwembo, Dr. Mbagwa Walusimbi, Dr. Lawrence Musanje, Dr. Solomon Ondoma, Mr. Herbert Ddungu (NP), Ms. Annette Kivumbi (BSN), abaali bawaddeyo obudde (volunteered) okulutambuza, nga bajjanjaba abantu ba Ssaabasajja mu bitundu ebyo. Tusuubira nti embeera bw'enetereera, abakulu bano baja kusitukiramu nate okwenyigira mu mulamwa guno.
- **Olulimi Oluganda:** Mu nkiiko ezibaddewo emabega, tuzze tusuubiza okukola ku kuyigiriza abaana baffe olulimi Oluganda. Ebibiina byaffe bingi, nga bwe munaalaba, bifubye okwagaza abana olulimi lwabwe. Nnina essanyu era okubategeza nti bannaffe aba Ggwanga Mujje Boston, balina entegeka ekwata ku mulamwa guno (curriculum) gye bakolako, egenda okuyamba abaana n'abo bona abali wabweru wa Buganda, abaagala okuyiga Oluganda.
- **Eddwaliro/Eryato eryo ku mazzi (Boat Ambulance):** Tweyama mu BBNAC 2019, okuyambako ku kaweeefube w'okugula Ambulance etambulira ku mazzi, naye bwe twekenneenya nnyo, twakizuula nga, emiwendo gya Ambulance eyo gya

kawereege, era ne twesanga nga tetulina busobozi obwo.

- **Million Dollar Project:** Mu BBNAC 2019, tweyama okuteekawo project eno. Nnina essanyu okubategeza nti omulimu guno gutambula bukwakku, era mu bufunze, bino wammanga bye bikoleddwako:

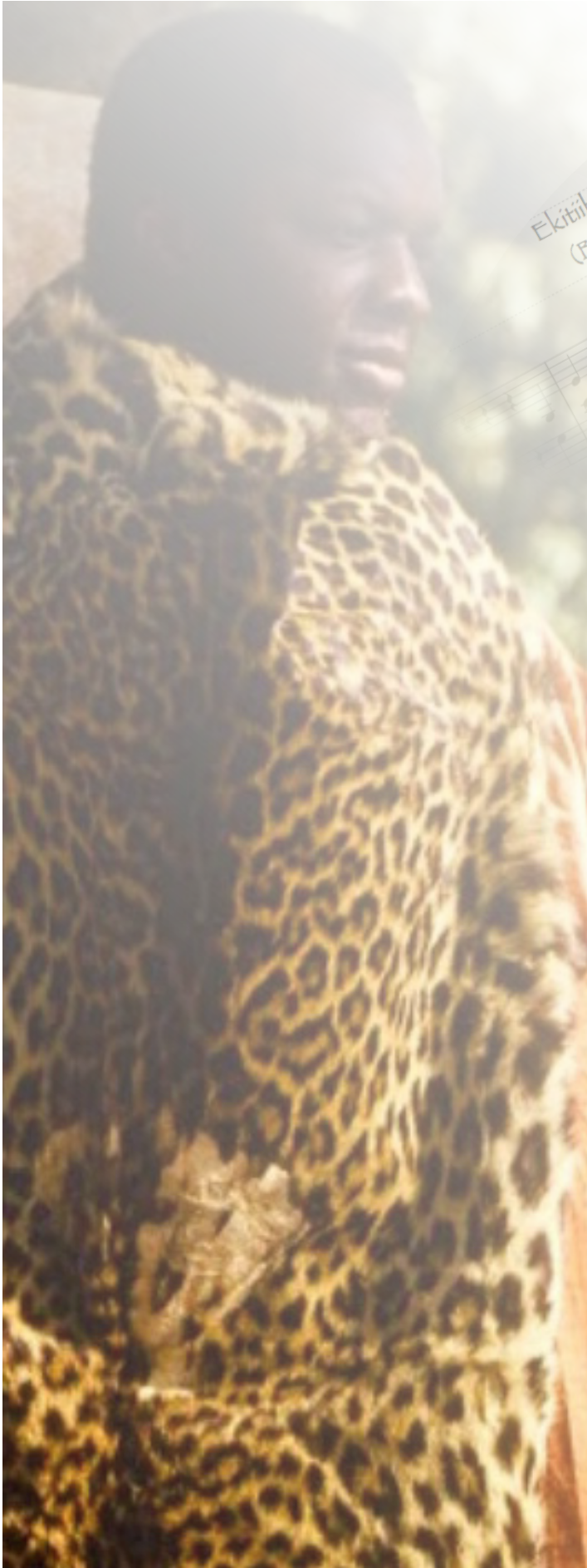

**THE CASE FOR FEDERALISM IN THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY: A  
STRATEGIC REVIEW OF  
AND NEW MANIFESTO TO GUIDE THE STRUGGLE FOR  
FEDERALISM IN UGANDA**

**1.0 INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This paper is prepared pursuant to the Second Tenet of the Kingdom's Five Core Tenets (*Ensonga Ssemasonga Ettaano*) and the Buganda Kingdom's Strategic Plan (*Enteekateeka Nnamutaayiika*) 2018 -2023. The Second Tenet speaks to Buganda's aspiration to a fair, equitable, transparent and sustainable division of power using a federal system of government.
- 1.2 This paper examines a brief history of federalism in Uganda and its failure. It examines the struggle restoration of federalism; its achievements and limitations. It is our central argument that whereas federalism can be restored to Uganda, there is an urgent need for a change of strategy on the part of the proponents of federalism. Advocates for federalism have concentrated on calling upon the Central Government to commence (or re-engage in) negotiations for the "restoration" of a federal government. Preparation for federalism on the part of the Buganda Kingdom has largely taken the form of debating, drafting and refining negotiation positions. This has lent itself to the mis-conceptualisation of the problem and also engendered a misrepresentation of the Kingdom's aspiration as a reactionary yearning for past glory or a return of feudalism. **We have come to perceive the quest for federalism largely as a legal/legislative pursuit rather than as the complex political effort that it truly is.** It is our contention that the fast changing political, demographic and economic factors are rendering the present strategy impractical and ineffective.
- 1.3 This paper advocates for the creation of a new alliance and new messaging. We advocate for the engagement in the creation of a new grassroots efforts across the country to win over a new generation to the idea of federalism as a guarantee for lasting peace, happiness, prosperity and stability in Uganda and elsewhere in Africa. We also advocate for the use of local, regional and international levers to achieve the long-standing goal of a federated Uganda. **Our aim should be to drive a new commitment to the federalism ideal and to put it at the heart of a new political consensus for Uganda. We need to develop and fine tune the message in language that speaks to the diverse (in terms of ethnicity, gender, socio-economic class etc.) generations of today and tomorrow. The case for federalism must be couched in terms of internationally recognised democratic rights. It must be progressive and inclusive. Federalism should come to be understood by the majority of the population as an essential guarantee of freedom, happiness and prosperity. Above all, the quest for federalism should be made practical; it should descend from the realm of ideas into simple practical steps that need to be taken.**
- 1.4 For the purposes of this paper we have adopted a simple definition of federalism. Federalism is a system of government, based on a written constitution, in which the same territory is controlled by two levels of government. Power is divided between a federal government and

The US education system is student centric. They concentrate on the students' personal and social growth, which contributes to their overall development. Educators in the United States favor vocational learning and employ realistic and practical methods. Projects are assigned to students on a daily basis. To complete those projects, they must work with all stakeholders (family, students, teachers, professors, and so on) to gain a comprehensive understanding of the topic. One might call it a type of networking. Although some schools across Uganda manage to make do with what they have (primarily in large cities), schools in smaller cities or villages (such as mine) are out-of-date, lack funding, and, while teachers may indeed be encouraging and inspired, it doesn't matter if the students aren't interested or motivated. The majority of this may be attributed to the students' social milieu and family circumstances.

Paul Kyegombe was born on Feb 3rd, 1972. He attended Mugwanya Preparatory School in Kabojja, and then proceeded to St. Savio Junior School in Kisubi and then continued his high school studies at St. Mary's College Kisubi, where he graduated at the top of his class in 1991. He was accepted at the Makerere University School of Engineering but received a scholarship shortly after to Huddersfield University in United Kingdom, where he pursued his bachelor's and master's degrees and graduated with honors as an architect.

Upon graduation, he worked for Dyer Brown and Associates in UK. In 2000, he moved to Massachusetts and worked for Dyer Brown Architects in Boston. After a few years, he relocated to Atlanta, Georgia, where he worked for Farrington Design Group and Leo A Daly Company, before starting his own architectural firm.

Paul was also a talented artist. He loved painting everything from politicians, city skylines, celebrities, and community members.

Paul founded Atlanta Cranes, a soccer team composed of mainly Ugandans, one that he coached on the weekends until his final days. He was known as 'Coach K', he added social events to the Atlanta Cranes, such as the annual summer picnic and the end-of-year gala, events that brought the community together. He also started the famous Atlanta Cranes Soccer Magazine that had inspiring stories of all players with their children. Paul was also a strong supporter and member of Buganda Bumu and was actively involved in the 2017 Convention that was held in Atlanta, Georgia.

Paul passed away on April 14th, 2020 at his home in Smyrna, Georgia, and is survived by his son, Solomon. Paul was a man of many gifts and is sorely missed by the Atlanta community, BBNAC, family and friends. May the Lord Rest his Soul in Eternal Peace.

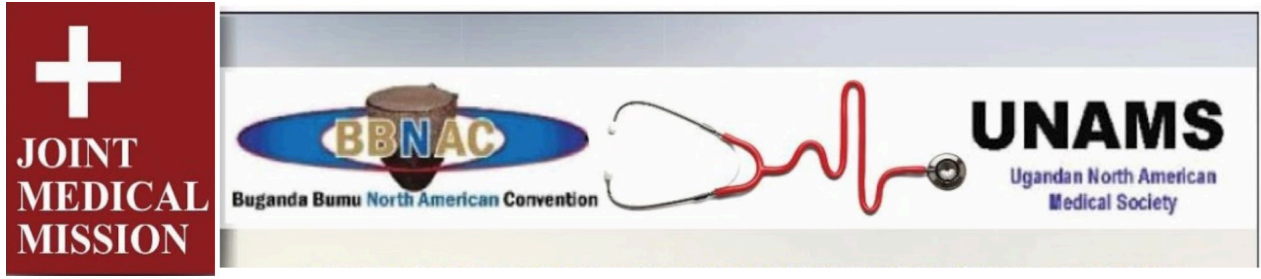
